

Good morning/afternoon

Following on from Round 2 of Saturday competition.

We must ensure that we maintain a high standard of vigilance for the duration of **all** HVNA competitions.

Again there are certain protocols that need to be enforced from a Club's perspective to their players, parents, coaches, umpires and the like.

They are:-

- Entry point to Macquarie Park Netball Courts is Court 4;
- Exit point from Macquarie Park Netball Courts is Court 1;
- Arrival at Grant Street Courts no earlier than 25 minutes before your game.
- First game of the day commences at 8:30 am and concludes at 9:16 am
- Second game of the day commences at 9:45 am and concludes at 10:31 am
- Third game of the day commences at 11:00 am and concludes at 11:46 am
- Fourth game of the day commences at 12:00 pm and concludes at 12:54 pm
- Fifth game of the day commences at 1:20 pm and concludes at 2:14 pm
- Sixth and final game of the day commences at 2:45 pm and concludes at 3:30 pm

At the conclusion of each game, the next team on that Court is responsible for cleaning the pole pads. There will be a spray bottle and wipes available for each Court.

HVNA will be sanitising all pens and scoreboards for the scorer of each team (Club first on the score sheet to collect) after each game. Players sign on their respective score sheets, with their own pen.

Please do not use the pen attached to the score board that the scorer is required to use.

Score board MUST be collected by the Coach or Manager. Do not send any player to collect.

Each team is responsible for sanitising their own game ball. Bibs may be shared amongst team members only. It is recommended that no over the shoulder bibs be used.

The number of spectators per game, per Court, in addition to those playing, is limited to **one (1) spectator per player only at each game.**

The spectators may not stand between the Courts. ***Spectators must stand at the end of each Court on the grass area, or for Courts 1 & 2 on the footpath.***

- One (1) parent/spectator per player;
- No parent contact with any player between quarters. In other words, players must stay with their coach.
- Parents must not go between the Courts whilst the game is being played or during break time.
- Player to meet their parent at the conclusion of the game on the grass area.
- Spectators must maintain a 1.5m distance from other persons at all times.
- Spectators ***must complete the attendance record for each game. [see attached]***

If we are unable to commit to these guidelines and the Public Health Order our competition, ***will cease immediately.***

Anyone not adhering to these procedures, has the potential to be fined.

Each Club must ensure that they have their Covid 19 Safety Officer and Plan available for viewing, should a Public Health or Police Officer request same either at training or match day.

The Association cannot emphasise enough the importance of adhering to these rules.
